It attracted criticism on account of the exclusion of several outlier groups such as women, people belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes, fisher folk, etc. Critics have also pointed out the question of the model's sustainability on account of fiscal and environmental limits.

Recent global, national and regional developments necessitate a revisit of both the strengths and weaknesses of the state's economy. Centralization of the fiscal system and the consequent shrinking of the fiscal space, climate change, growth in inequality on account of globalization, high rates of educated unemployment of the youth, especially among women, population aging and related issues of geriatric care, growing incidents of human-animal conflicts, rehabilitation of return migrants, infrastructure deficit, etc. are significant in the current context. The Kerala Economic Conference 2025 seeks to address some of these issues.

The conference will be inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala. It will bring together a galaxy of eminent scholars from within and outside Kerala. Plenary session will be organised in honour of K.N. Raj, M. Kunhaman, K.K. Subramanian and K K George.
