About the Workshop

Rigorous empirical investigation is paramount for advancing knowledge and informing policy. This intensive five-day national workshop is designed to equip early-career researchers and academics with the essential skills to effectively leverage unit-level data from key National Statistical Office (NSO) surveys, specifically the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), the Time Use Survey (TUS), and the Annual Survey of Industries (ASI). The workshop will provide participants with hands-on training in utilizing statistical software packages, including SPSS and R Studio, for data management and analysis.

Participants will gain

- ➔ Exposure to empirical research using household and employment surveys.
- ➔ Hands-on sessions in data extraction, merging, and cleaning.
- ➔ Skills in analyzing and visualizing socioeconomic datasets relevant to Indian public policy.

Core objective of the workshop is to foster a deeper understanding of these vital datasets and cultivate the analytical capabilities necessary for conducting impactful research in diverse fields of academic inquiry. By integrating conceptual understanding with practical application, this workshop aims to empower participants to contribute meaningfully to their respective areas of research.
